

Dual Credit Information

DUAL-CREDIT STUDENTS need to remember that once you are enrolled in a college class, you can't get back in the replacement class during the current semester here at LaPoynor H.S. if you later decide to drop the class, or if you are failing the class. We are not offering independent studies this year, so you will not receive credit for the dropped/failed dual credit class. This could have serious implications for graduating seniors, so please do your best in your college classes. Keep your work turned in on time, and study for all tests! It is a sacrifice to take dual-credit classes, but it will be worth it in the end!

DON'T FORGET...

In order to be able to take English IV replacement classes at TVCC, you must first take ENG 1301 and ENG 1302 at the college level. These courses are prerequisites for ENG 2322, ENG 2323, ENG 2326, ENG 2332, and ENG 2333, etc. (all sophomore-level English classes)

The following courses are commonly taken as replacement dual credit classes (student will receive both high school and college credit as long as the student maintains an "a" or "B" in the college class):

English III – ENG 1301, ENG 1302

ENGLISH IV – ENG 2322, 2323, 2326, 2332, 2333

Speech (CommApp) – SPCH 1311

Government – GOVT 2301 or GOVT 2302

Economics – ECON 2301 or ECON 2302

U.S. History – HIST 1301, HIST 130

More Dual Credit Info

Beginning in the 2008-09 school year, we will offer online dual-credit/college credit classes on the LaPoynor High School campus, during school hours.

Fall 2008:

- HIST 1301 (facilitated by Ms. Mulholland)
- ENGL 1301 (facilitated by Mrs. Bandy)

Spring 2009:

- HIST 1302 (facilitated by Ms. Mulholland)
- ENGL 1302 (facilitated by Mrs. Bandy)

College Credit Info

Dual-credit classes allow the student to receive both high school credit and college credit. If a student wishes to take a college class, and its replacement high school-level class **is not** offered at LaPoynor High School, the student has the option of taking the class at TVCC for college credit only, rather than for dual-credit.

College Credit Classes:

- **may be** taken at TVCC with the counselor's permission
- **will be** recorded on the student's TVCC college transcript
- **will be** figured into the student's college grade point average at TVCC
- **will be** available at full tuition cost

College Credit Classes:

- **will not be** recorded on the student's high school transcript
- **will not be** figured into the student's high school grade point average
- **will not be** eligible for ½ price tuition scholarship offered by TVCC
